### TODAY AT IMMANUEL:

Evening Worship: 6:00 - Explore this morning's theme more deeply. Come with your questions or comments about the scripture and message, listen to a brief teaching from Tim Keller that digs deeper into the theme, and consider how we can seek the well-being and flourishing of the city of Ripon.

Morning Worship: 8:30/11:00 - Gospel in Life – Heart: Three Ways to Live, Luke 18:9-14. Irreligion, religion, or the gospel – which one speaks the way of your heart? Irreligion is obvious; but too often we confuse religion for the gospel. We'll consider what Jesus says about a gospel way of life.
